VERBAL REASONING

VERBAL TESTS are designed to determine your ability to identify with written information and to evaluate arguments about this information. In a verbal reasoning test, you are regularly provided with a passage of text followed by one or more statements. In the example below, determine whether each statement is true or false, or whether you cannot say, given the information in the passage:

A - True (the statement follows logically from the information or opinions contained in the passage)

B - False (the statement is logically false from the information or opinions contained in the passage)

C - Cannot say (cannot determine whether the statement is true or false without further information)

Example:

"Many organizations discover it beneficial to employ students in excess of the summer. Permanent staff often wish to take their own holidays over this period. Besides, it is not rare for companies to experience peak workloads in the summer and so need extra staff. Summer service also attracts students who may return as well-qualified recruits to an organization when they have completed their education. Ensuring that the students learn as much as possible about the organization encourages interest in working on a permanent basis. Organizations pay students on a fixed rate without the usual privilege to paid holidays or bonus schemes."
